I was just in Portland to clean out my mother-in-laws apartment. We went to DI and they had Emergency Wool Blankets that are made of 30% wool (100% is better of course). They are selling them for \$2. They are normally about \$20. My daughter just bought some on sale in Houston for \$12 from a mail order emergency supply place. I purchased 12 of them. I am going back down to Portland next Saturday. If you would like to get one or two, they have 40 more in stock. If you want to see them come by my house and Janice will let you look at them. The reason you use a wool blanket in an emergency is because it will still keep you warm even when you are wet. No other fabric will do that. If you want to see one, come by my house and Janice will let you look at it. If you want to purchase some, please bring the money by before Saturday. We will be leaving early Saturday morning and I am willing to go get some for you if you want them.
