I had a roll of 1000 denier nylon fabric from a job I used to have in a sewing factory in Utah just laying around. And I had a whole bunch of nylon bag straps laying around from that era too. So I asked Loa Anderson helped me make this portable stretcher. Was pretty easy to make and we sewed it on a regular home sewing machine with a heavy duty needle and nylon thread.



That is my son David as the demo doll.... Love the color... no chance of not been seen in a disaster with that baby.....

Either 6 people can carry the injured person or you can put two poles through the straps and 2 people can carry the injured person like a normal stretcher. Because it is made of nylon it can be folded up and stored in a little bag.
